



UMPIRES CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

UMPIRE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Umpire in accordance with the Official Rules of the Game. Umpires are required to provide their own equipment for officiating at match.
- Treat all players, coaches, bench officials and other umpires with respect.
- Umpires shall remain detached and neutral when officiating at matches. Umpires should develop a rapport with players during matches.
- Place the safety and welfare of the players above all else, including:
 - Ensuring the court and its surrounds are compliant with the rules.
 - Taking appropriate action to manage dangerous play.
- Be a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring at all times. Umpires shall at all times represent their Club with dignity and sportsmanlike behaviour.
- Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual harassment, discrimination, bullying and/or victimisation.
- Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction with other netball participants.
- Maintain or improve your current performance level and seek continual improvement. Umpires shall attend training as required by the Umpire Coach / Coordinator.
